



Mobile Phone and iPod Policy

- Due to the fact that students travel from far and wide to attend Smith's Hill, mobile phones are an accepted part of the school. Despite this, mobile phones are meant to be turned off and in bags during class time.
- Any student who is caught with their mobile phone out of their bag will be reminded of the school policy and asked to put the phone away. If the behaviour persists, the phone will be confiscated and the phone will need to be picked up at the front office at the end of the day.
- If students fail to comply with the above, there may be further consequences in line with the [Fair Discipline Policy](#).
- Many students also carry iPods or mp3 players to help cope with the travel. Again, despite this, iPods and mp3 players are meant to be turned off and in bags during class time. The same procedures apply as set out for mobile phones when dealing with students who have their device out of their bag.
